Introducing CATI Fieldwork

- Proven methods of doing fieldwork in African countries, no matter how successful, need to be adjusted to cope with the challenges of mandatory social distancing
- We have, therefore, taken the step of revisiting our databases, which we have built up over the past 10 years
- In several countries across East and West Africa, we now offer to our clients CATI surveys among general consumer publics
- Respondents in these data bases have opted in (or will be asked for informed consent) to participating in market research surveys; standards set by GDPR, ICC/ESOMAR, and the various local professional associations, are being strictly adhered to
- In addition, of course, we offer RDD CATI fieldwork









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









Panel Demographics: Sierra Leone








Qualitative Panels

- "Cold recruiting" may not be an option in all countries, as regulations of social distancing measures vary greatly
- Our past experience working on different qualitative projects has given us an opportunity to build a platform that allows us to interact with a diverse group of respondents in order to recruit for any given study
- Across our most important markets in East and West Africa, we are also continuing to screen eligible respondents for qualitative projects:
 - Online Bulletin Boards (e.g. Google Classroom, WhatsApp)
 - In-depth Interviews (e.g. Skype)
 - Video Focus Groups (e.g. Zoom)
- Before being invited to participate in a specific project, eligibility is ascertained:
 - Meeting all recruitment criteria
 - Not having participated in research during the past 12 months









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
