



# Perception of Donald Trump among urban Kenyans

# Methodology

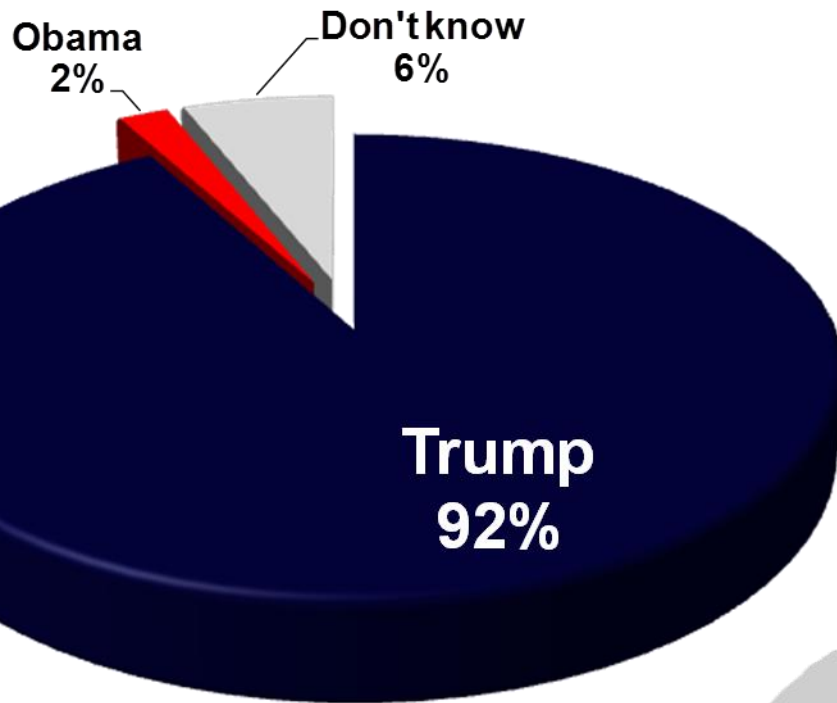
- Infinite Insight wanted to measure Kenyans' perceptions of Donald Trump
- Hence, we ran 4 questions piggyback on a nationally representative survey among urban Kenyans
- The sample distribution was as follows:

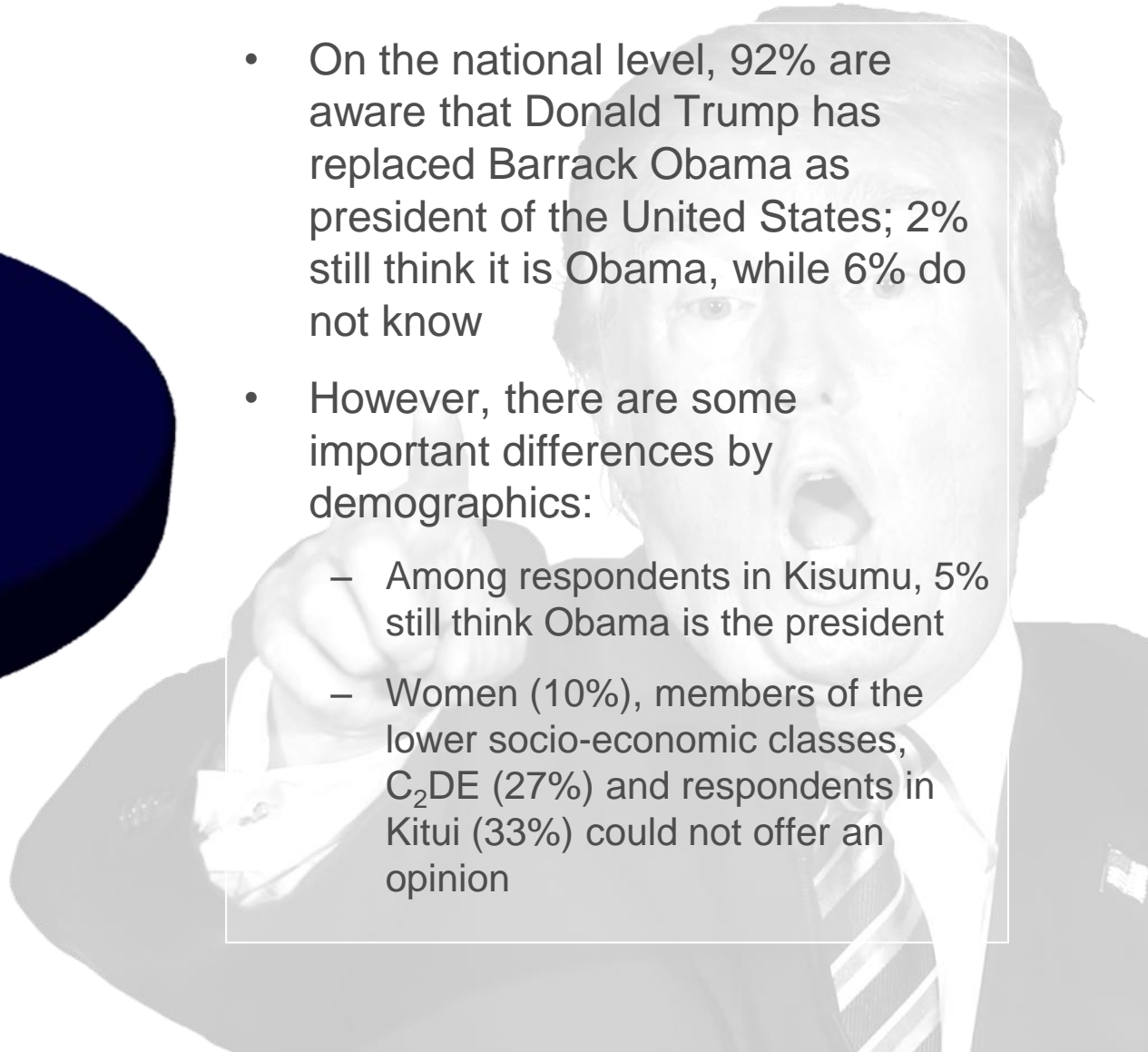
- Sampling followed multi-stage random procedures with Kish-Grid selection of respondents, aged 15 and above
- Fieldwork started on Tuesday, May 30<sup>th</sup>, and concluded on Sunday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017
- The margin of error is  $\pm 2.9\%$  at 95% confidence

# Awareness of Trump's Presidency

(Base: Total Sample, n=1,049)



- On the national level, 92% are aware that Donald Trump has replaced Barrack Obama as president of the United States; 2% still think it is Obama, while 6% do not know
- However, there are some important differences by demographics:
  - Among respondents in Kisumu, 5% still think Obama is the president
  - Women (10%), members of the lower socio-economic classes, C<sub>2</sub>DE (27%) and respondents in Kitui (33%) could not offer an opinion



# Rating of Trump's Performance in Office So Far

- Half of our respondents opined that Trump's performance was neither good nor bad (30%) or could not volunteer an assessment (20%); however, among the remaining half, positive ratings outweighed negative ones: 34% rated Trump's performance so far as *Good/Very Good*, while just 17% rated his performance *Bad/Very Bad*
- Given the high level of uncertainty among many (and positive ratings among the rest), it seems Kenyans still reserve their judgement; compared to other parts of the world, they have not been affected by travel bans or drastic reductions of financial support by the United States

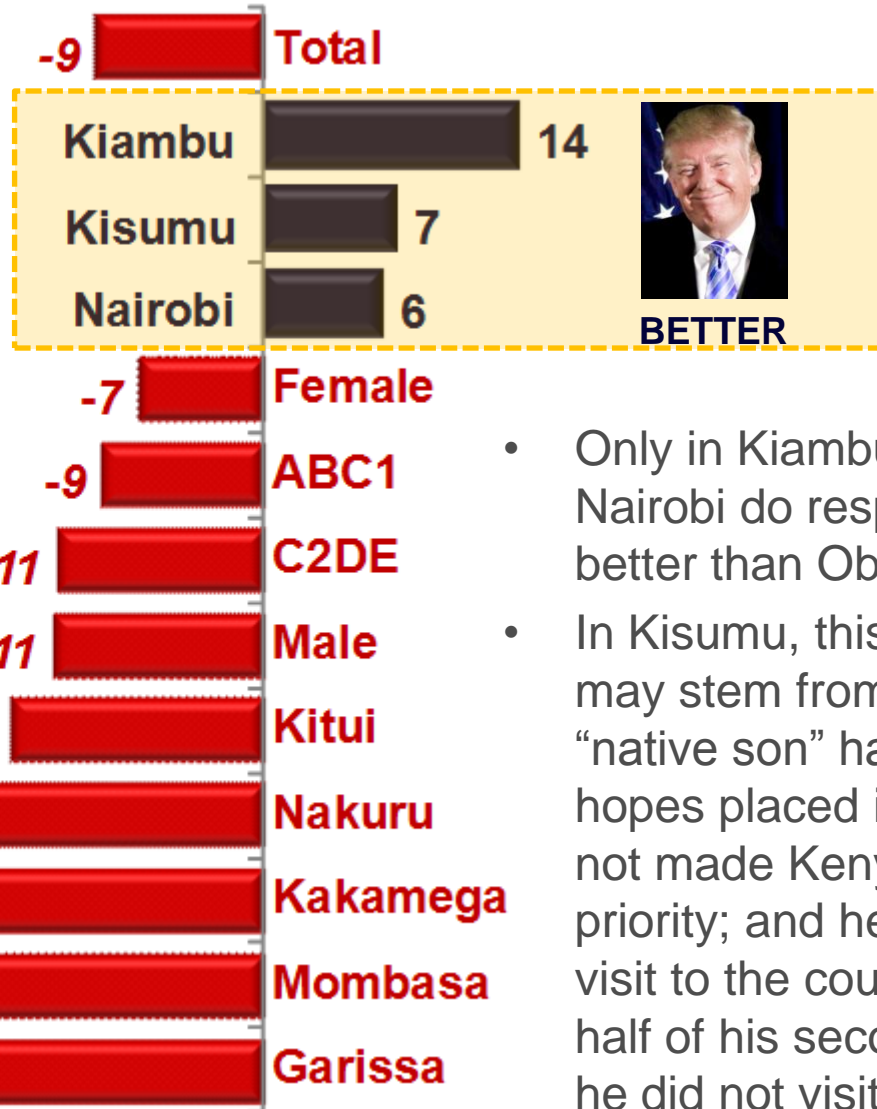
# Comparison of Trump vs. Obama

(Net Scores: **Better** minus **Worse**)

- Nevertheless, across most of demographic groups, Trump cannot measure up to former president Obama



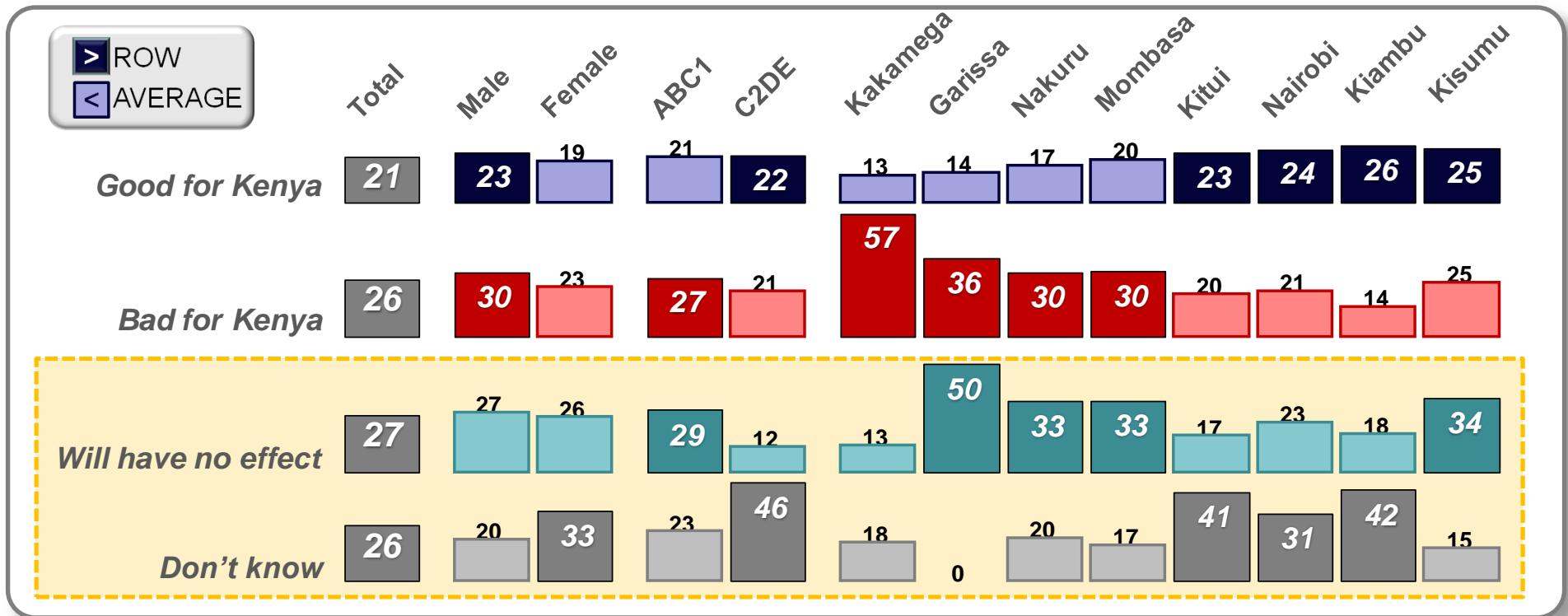

- Only in Kiambu, Kisumu and Nairobi do respondents rate Trump better than Obama
- In Kisumu, this surprising result may stem from the fact that the “native son” had not met the high hopes placed in him; Obama had not made Kenya his top policy priority; and he delayed his only visit to the country until the second half of his second term; even then, he did not visit his ancestral village

# Expected Impact of the Trump Presidency on Kenya



- Kenyans, who live in urban areas, appear very much uncertain what the effect of emerging Trump policies will be on the country; at the national level, over half think there will be no effect (27%) or do not know (26%)
- So far, president Trump has not voiced strong opinions on Africa in general or Kenya in particular; hence, Kenyans take a “wait and see” attitude
